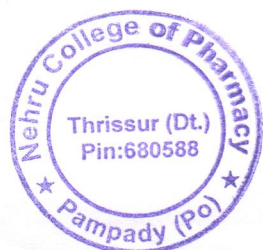
In the field of research and publication totally there are 13 research articles published by our faculty during 2020-21, the details are given below.

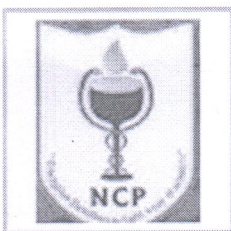
In the academic year 2020-21 only final year Pharm D could attend the placement drives whereas other students from B Pharm and M. Pharm could not because of the delay in academic calendar.

MOUs

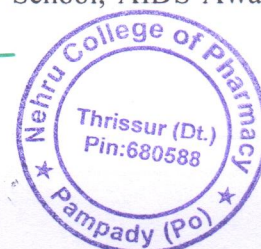

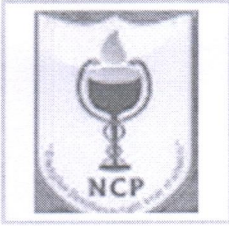
NSS AND OUTREACH ACTIVITIES

SEMINARS/FACULTY TRAINING PROGRAMS

Nehru College of Pharmacy conducted ONE FDP, 12 seminars and ONE Management Training Program in which 40 faculty and 16 non-teaching staff got benefited. 18 teaching faculties attended online FDP on Current Trends in online teaching strategy conducted by Nehru Management School.

VALUE ADDED COURSES

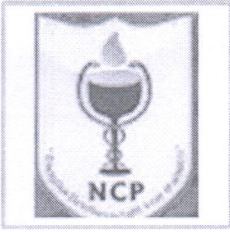
FACULTY FINANCE SUPPORT

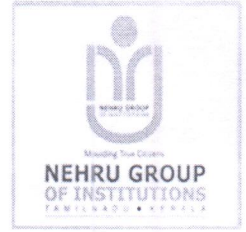
